OUR VISION

Castle Island enrolls 55 students with a vision of enrollment growth to capacity of 125 children: Early Childhood (age 3) through Adolescence (8th Grade). We believe that every child deserves access to world-class education, opening them up to life with daily opportunities to learn at their own pace, following their own interests, and to participate as contributing members in an authentic community to emerge into their own individual fantastic best selves, achieving academical rigor while also realizing global citizenship.

July 1, 2016	Launched Spanish Immersion Summer Camps & Parent/Toddler Program
July 1, 2018	Relocated to Capital District LATINOS expanding to 3 classrooms, art studio, bilingual library & courtyard garden space
July 1, 2019	American Montessori Society candidacy for accreditation
March 1, 2022	Relocated to New Facility designed with intension to house our Montessori program
